Margaret Dorothea Moser was born September 9, 1915 in Harvey to Karl and Anna (Mees) Moser. She graduated from Harvey High School and attended North Dakota State University and Oregon State University, studying microbiology. She was a member of Kappa Kappa Gamma sorority.

On June 14, 1937, in Corvallis, Ore., Margaret married William H. Keup. They lived in Molalla, Ore., where he taught vocational agriculture. In 1940, they moved to Mohall and established a farming operation, raising grain and turkeys. They were joined by Ross and Norma Cook and the operation became Cook & Keup, continuing in both grain farming and turkey production.

Her husband, Bill, died in 1991. In 1995, Margaret moved from the Mohall farm to Topeka to live with her daughter, Mary Kay, and family.
