Mildred was born July 17, 1910 in Muskego Township, Renville County, near Foxholm to Joseph and Margaret (Fuerstenberg) Ahmann. She was raised in the Foxholm area and attended school there.

Mildred married Daniel John Gehringer March 4, 1935 in Mohall. They lived in Brandon Township, Renville County, for many years until moving into Mohall in 1987. Daniel died March 29, 1989.

Mildred was a member of St. Jerome Catholic Church, Mohall, the Confraternity of Christian Mothers and the Altar Society.
