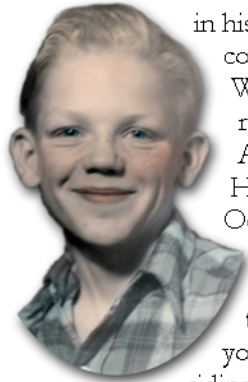


Willis Julson

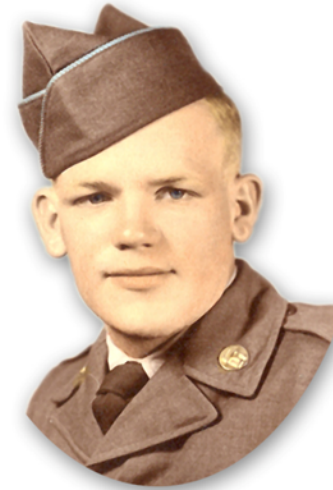
Willy was preceded in death by his parents, Noble and Martha Julson; and father-in-law, Merle Jones.
